QUICK OVERVIEW FOR EDUCATORS

In One Instant is an award-winning teen safe driving video program made by teens - for teens, with followup activities that can be done In-Person or Virtually. It's been implemented in over 3,500 schools nationwide. In One Instant makes the topic of distracted, reckless, and impaired driving personal and relevant. The program helps teens to stay safe behind the wheel, and influence their friends and family to do the same.

Implementing the In One Instant Teen Safe Driving Video Program at your school is simple and easy. Student Leaders will understand how to host In One Instant in the classroom, as an assembly, or online by following these steps:

STEP 1: Get Your School On Board

Sign Up your school for the program at: [Get the Program](#) which is also located on our website. It's FREE, thanks to our generous donors and sponsors.

STEP 2: Select teen leaders and other educators who want to do the program.

STEP 3: Schedule date(s), time(s), and location(s) to implement the program. It can be done in one class period or expanded over multiple sessions throughout the year.

STEP 4: Program Package

Program Package will be emailed to each Educator and Student Leader who signs up. Includes a private link to the Video and links to our easy-to-use Educator's Guide and Student Leader's Guide. (Also included are Teen Driving Tips/Community Service Opportunities and Parent Handbook). Guides can also be found on our website: inoneinstant.org. All content has been prepared for you and is ready to implement!

STEP 5: Have students complete the anonymous 3-minute pre-survey during the week before the program, and the post-survey within 3 days following implementation (online)

STEP 6: Download the In One Instant Video

Once you have received your In One Instant Program Package, make sure to download the Video to view at maximum quality, and especially to avoid buffering or streaming issues.

STEP 7: Choose Your Follow-up Activities

All activities can be found in the Educator's Guide. Be sure to choose activities and have links available to utilize after the video has concluded. Below are activities that can be used during in-person or virtual sessions:
