

SCHOOL EMERGENCY & PARENT/STUDENT REUNIFICATION INFO

As a parent, feeling confident in the safety of your child at the school they attend is essential. At Umergency, the safety of your child is our mission. In the event of an emergency, our app will provide you and your student with the necessary information and vital tools all in one place. While no one can predict when an emergency will happen, we can be prepared for one. The following information is a step-by-step outline designed to help support you and your family through any school emergency.

-THINGS TO KNOW-

PLEASE STAY HOME

- Please stay home.
- Know that Police, Fire and District personnel will be working to resolve the situation.
- Please do not come to the school

STAY INFORMED

- Please be sure that your contact information, including phone number and email address, are updated with your school.
- Do not text your child. It may put them at risk.
- Do not call the school - all communications will be made via the district web site.
- In some cases, students may be asked to send a text message to a parent or guardian.

BE READY

- Your school's district will notify parents and guardians using mass phone calls or texts.
- Reunification is a system-wide release once your identification has been verified.
- Schools will reunite students with parents as soon as it is safe and possible to do so.
- These situations typically take time to implement, so patience is required.

BE PREPARED

- Parents and guardians will need a photo ID and a reunification slip.
- The reunification slip should be provided at the reunification station.
- Be sure to upload the front and back of your ID.

BE PATIENT

- The reunification process may take several hours, or even require overnight coordination.
- School administration and staff will maintain responsibilities until the event has concluded.
- The web site for your child's school district will be the source for certain announcements. The link for your student's web site is located on your profile screen in the app.

NOTE: *If your child goes to a private school, please check their school web site for emergency procedures and announcements.*

- Different emergencies will create different paths for reunification.
- There is a process for every potential emergency and deviating from the plan can make the situation worse.
