## **KEY RISKS FOR TEEN DRIVERS**

- Unfamiliar Terrain: Winding roads, blind curves, steep hills
- Unpredictable Hazards:
   Wildlife, farm equipment, loose gravel,
   limited cell service
- Limited Visibility:
   No streetlights, fog, overgrown vegetation

### **ESSENTIAL SAFETY TIPS**

### 1. BE PREPARED

- Carry an emergency kit
- Ensure your phone is charged
- Let someone know your route and ETA
- Always buckle up

### 2. MAINTAIN YOUR VEHICLE

- Check tire pressure and tread regularly
- Keep windshield and headlights clean
- Ensure all lights are working properly
- Fill up on gas before your long journey

### 3. SLOW DOWN

- Reduce speed on unfamiliar roads
- Your life matters more than arriving quickly

### 4. STAY ALERT

- Scan the road ahead using the 5-Second Rule
- Watch for slow-moving vehicles

# 5. AVOID DISTRACTIONS

- Put your phone away
- Limit passengers
- Pull over if you need to use your phone

### If Something Goes Wrong

- 1. STAY CALM AND SAFELY PULL OVER
- 2. TURN ON HAZARD LIGHTS
- 3. CALL 911
- 4. STAY IN YOUR CAR UNLESS UNSAFE
