



More Likely Pedestrians Will Die By Car Crashes On Halloween

Why Teens Are at Higher Risk

- · October = deadliest month for teen drivers
- 3X higher crash rate at night vs adults
- · Every passenger doubles your crash risk
- 39% of Halloween crashes involve alcohol

How to Keep Everyone Safe

- · Drive 5-10 mph slower in neighborhoods
- Scan sidewalks & driveways constantly
- Turn headlights on early
- · Assume kids will dart into streets
- Make eye contact with pedestrians before proceeding
- · Limit passengers on Halloween night
- · Zero alcohol ever

If You're Walking Around

- · Carry a flashlight be visible!
- · Don't assume drivers see you at night
- · Make eye contact with drivers before crossing
- · Walk with younger siblings? You're their safety guide
